As I am sitting at my desk in late May writing this message, I am realizing how quickly time flies by. As you are reading this, we have already been together for just about a year! That's right. Rabbi Boxt and TBS have been "dating" now for a year. And what a great year it has been. We have accomplished so much, and yet we also have so much more to do. Now I will admit that I have not had the opportunity yet to spend the kind of time I want with each and every one of you. There are

some members of this congregation to whom I have become very close. There are others who I know just casually, and there are still some who I may only know by face. M challenge for the next year is to actually spend time, real quality time, with every one with whom I have not had the chance.

This may seem like quite an expectation. With a congregation of approximately 120 families, we have around 400 members. I am the rabbi to all 400. We have increased our religious school by almost double! We have welcomed new families into our congregation pretty much every month in the past year. Our Passover Seder was a great success! Hanukkah, Sukkot, the HHD – so many things to celebrate! This year, thanks to a very generous donation, we will have a brand new sukkah that will seat 80 people! There are more opportunities out there – we just need to do everything we can to make it happen!

The word \* opportunity \* is a funny one. We are always looking for more opportunities to do things, whether it is to expand our membership or to create community within our membership. I want to explore the etymological meaning of the word opportunity: c.1400, from Old French opportun and directly from Latin opportunus "fit, convenient, suitable, favorable," from the phrase ob portum veniens "coming toward a port," in reference to the wind, from ob "to, toward" + portus "harbor."

We have had many "convenient, favorable or suitable" experiences in the past year. We find ourselves right now in a very favorable situation – an energetic and young rabbi (me) and a congregation of great people who are engaged and want to be even more engaged. We are moving "toward" our goal – which is the continued expansion of our congregation...yes, OUR congregation. I believe my family belongs here as well. Let us continue to work together to make TBS the hippest and most happening synagogue area – and even in the world!

My prayer for us in the upcoming year is that we will continue to embrace each other; we will continue to grow and learn about each other, and most importantly, we will continue to support each other!

#### TAX BENEFITS FROM YOUR RMD

The IRA charitable rollover (also called a Qualified Charitable Distribution or QCD) is a smart-tax way to support the Temple. The IRS has declared that charitable donations made directly from one of your tax-deferred accounts will be exempt from taxation up to \$100,000 as long as the distribution comes from a qualified account and is donated to a charity that meets the IRS stipulation.

Temple Beth Shalom meets the requirements. This means that a Temple member who has a tax-deferred account and must take a Required Minimum

Distribution (RMD) may request the custodian of the account to send directly to the Temple whatever amount they request, and that payment will count toward the required distribution, but that amount will not be considered taxable income. This is a great way to make a donation, pay your dues, satisfy your RMD, and reduce your taxes at the same time.



A Jewish member beyond the age of Bar/Bat Mitzvah may lead a religious service, or take part in a Torah reading, candle blessing or Kiddush, as these are sancta reserved for Jews. A Jewish family member may participate in the remainder of the service.

A non-Jewish parent of a Bar/Bat Mitzvah may participate in ceremonies such as:

Presentation of Tallit.

Blessing of the child.

Congratulatory speech.

Readings.

Presenting or receiving certificates and gifts of Jewish import, e.g., tallit mezuzah, menorah, Kiddush cup, candlesticks, Havdalah set, Tanakh, siddur.

Passing the Torah scroll to friends or kin as a sign of support for their Jewish journeys and enrichment. Whenever possible, the final passing shall give preference Jew to
