As the calendar turns to March, the weather is beginning to (finally) warm up! The evenings are becoming very nice and soon we will be complaining about how hot it is. This month, we celebrate Purim. On Friday, March 22, we will have some of Megillat Esther recited by Andrea Caufield. Following her reading, we will then have our very own Dr. Seuss themed Purim Shpiel. During our celebration of Purim, we often “turn things upside down.”

In Hebrew, the phrase is *Venahafoch hu*. Chapter 9, verse 1 of Megillat Esther teaches, “And so, on the thirteenth day of the twelfth month – that is, the month of Adar – when the king’s command and decree were to be executed, the very day on which the enemies of the Jews had expected to get them in their power, the opposite happened, and the Jews got their enemies in their power.” Rather than being destroyed by the hands of Haman (BOO!), we see Haman being hung on the same gallows he built for the Jews.

What else? Well, many dress in costume (please come as your favorite Dr. Seuss character) to represent an idea very foreign to Judaism: making fun of each other. In Judaism, we are taught that embarrassing someone can be equated to killing them...but on Purim, we take the act of laughing at others very seriously. Another “rule” on Purim – we are to get so drunk that we can’t tell difference between Haman and Mordechai. I will be drinking water and/or grape juice! On Friday, March 22, I hope you will join us for a fun and uplifting celebration of Purim! Thank you in advance to all of the actors who will be playing a part in this year’s Purim Shpiel. It should be a lot of fun – with lots of laughs!

Oneg Reminder

Temple Beth Shalom shall maintain a Kosher style kitchen, which means no treif food may be prepared, cooked, plated and/or served. Milk and meat items must be kept separated.
