At first, I was taken aback...as I write all the time! However, after giving it some thought, I realized it has been quite a long time since I shared with the congregation some of my prayers/poems that I have written. Truth be told, I have been in a bit of a writer's block for some time. Yes, I have written a few things here and there. However, the motivation I once had had been waning. Hearing the request, though, has given me a chance to reflect on what is truly important and what might help motivate me to write more. After all, the High Holy Days are coming up – and of course that requires quite a bit of writing!

During the Covid Pandemic, I wrote prayers almost every day. Even when I was sleeping, I was woken up from time to time with a thought for my next prayer. These days, there is so much going on in the world, I often find it difficult to focus enough on one issue/challenge/problem. TAX BENEFITS FROM YOUR RMD

The IRA charitable rollover (also called a Qualified Charitable Distribution or QCD) is a smart-tax way to support the Temple. The IRS has declared that charitable donations made directly from one of your tax-deferred accounts will be exempt from taxation up to \$100,000 as long as the distribution comes from a qualified account and is donated to a charity that meets the IRS stipulation.

Temple Beth Shalom meets the requirements. This means that a Temple member who has a tax-deferred account and must take a **Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)** may request the custodian of the account to send directly to the Temple whatever amount they request, and that payment will count toward the required distribution, but that amount will not be considered taxable income. This is a great way to make a donation, pay your dues, satisfy your RMD, and reduce your taxes at the same time.
