Message from the treasurer

Lots of changes in the treasurer's office. Goodbye from the outgoing treasurer, Janet Kreisman. Hello from the incoming treasurer, Barry Hartman. The new email address for the treasurer is ocalatbtreasurer@gmail.com and the new personal phone number is 352 216 9630 (please leave a brief message).

Annual dues for 2026-2027 increased 3% per By Laws article Six section IV. Family membership (2 or more adults plus qualifying children) is now \$1,545. Single (Individual) membership (1 person) is now \$927. Single Family (Single Parent or Individual Family) membership (1 adult plus qualifying children) is now \$1,133. Associate (Affiliate) membership (living outside Marion and contiguous counties) and Candidate (Conversion Class member) membership is now \$515.

Temple Beth Shalom began the process of switching management software from Rakefet to ShulCloud in May. When the switch is complete, all members will be notified of how to obtain access to their accounts in the new management software. For financial information, only non-zero balances were exported from Rakefet, without the years of supporting detail, to become starting balances in ShulCloud (such as unpaid dues, capital fund, yearbook, security, religious school, and high holy day pledges). For those who made payments after the export from Rakefet, those will be applied to balances in ShulCloud. Once access to ShulCloud is available, please confirm new balances. When discrepancies are found, please be patient with your incoming treasurer. ShulCloud handles names, addresses and Yahrzeits differently from Rakefet, so please confirm your information once access to ShulCloud is available. Again, when discrepancies are found, please be patient with your incoming treasurer.

Tax statements of potentially deductible contributions will be sent in 2 parts for 2026. A partial year statement for January through the switchover date in May will be sent from Rakefet. Another partial year statement from the switchover date in May through December will be sent from ShulCloud. Please remember to add the numbers on these 2 partial year statements to determine total 2026 contributions. When discrepancies are found, please be patient with your incoming treasurer.
